They also make Shemagh, which is daily used by local people. Another product is natural honey. which was made from various flowers in the Petra region.

The association particularly support local people with disabilities. They produce loom product from natural wool in different shapes and sizes. The wool is dyed in natural plants such as sumac, berries, and turmeric. Another product is wool knitting product, including clothing and muffler. Based on their environmentally friendly ideas, they also make beads products with recycled materials.
